

HAWAII ENDORSEMENT STATEMENT

2002

Pursuant to the agreement of the State of Hawaii to join the Pacific States/British Columbia Oil Spill Task Force, as indicated by the signature of the Honorable Benjamin Cayetano, Governor of Hawaii, to the Oil Spill Memorandum of Cooperation on May 22, 2001, the Hawaii Department of Health, Environmental Health Administration, hereby endorses the following Resolutions and Agreements previously adopted by the States/British Columbia Oil Spill Task Force:

- The 1993 Incident Command System for a Unified Approach to Marine Oil Spill Response Agreement
- The 1993 Mutual Aid Agreement
- The 1997 Mutual Aid Agreement
- The 1994 Resolution on Marine Salvage
- The 1997 Resolution on Federal Delegation of Authorities under OPA '90
